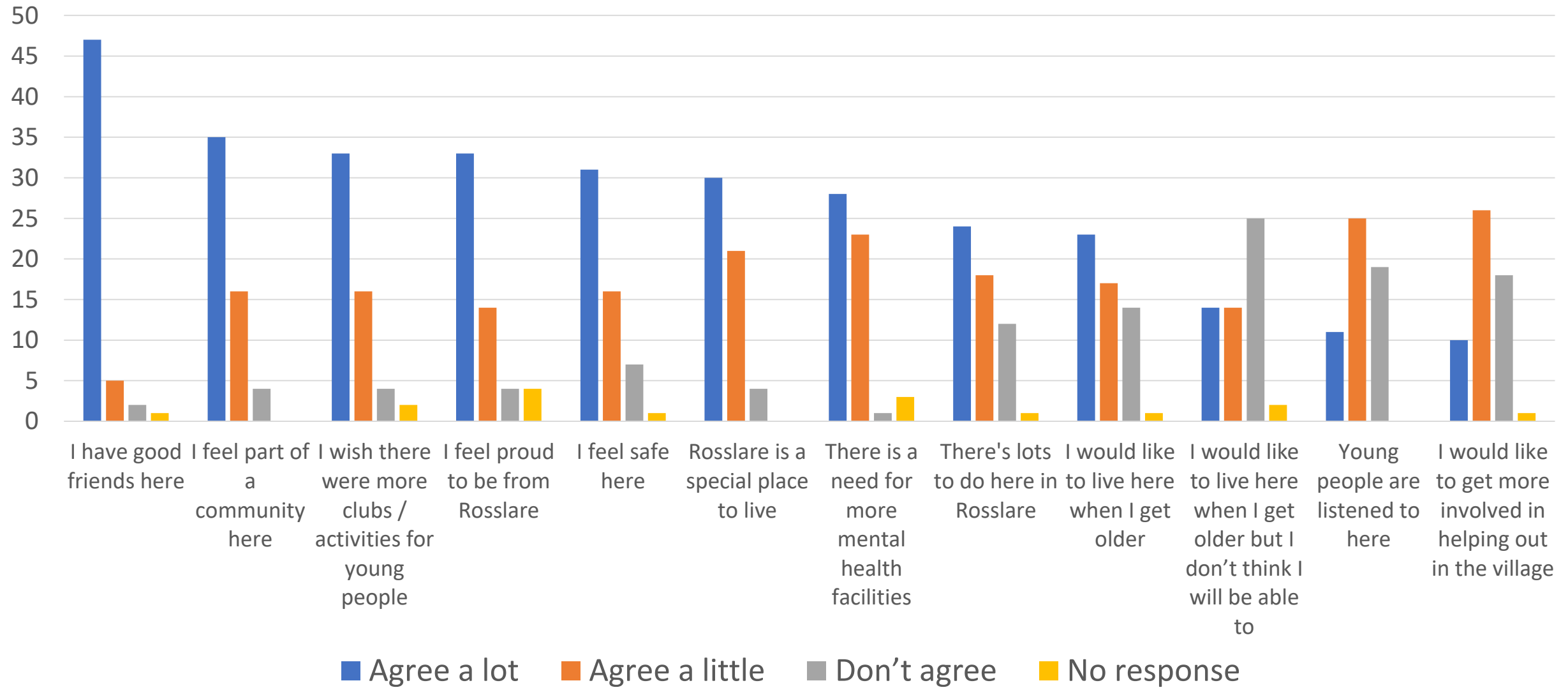

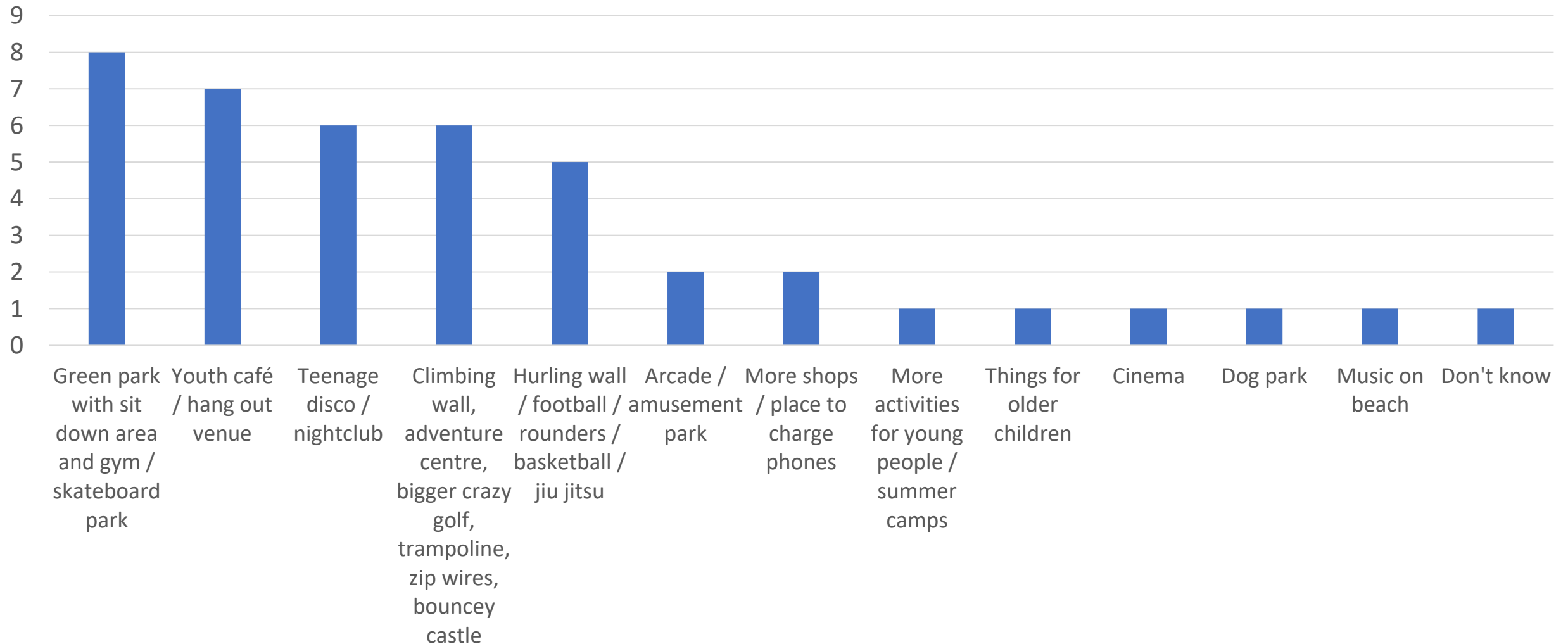
Question 1: How important are the following to you?



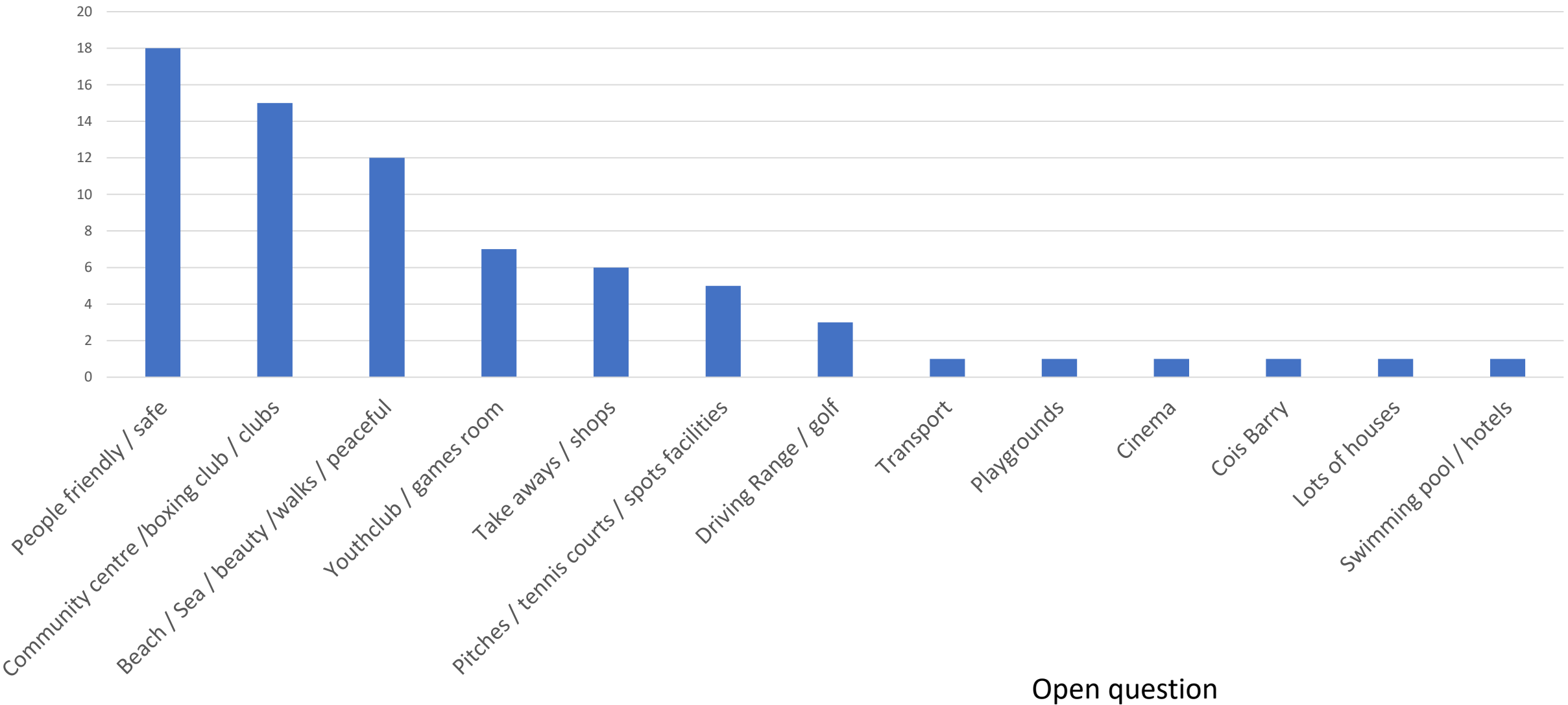
Question 2: What is your opinion on the following statements?



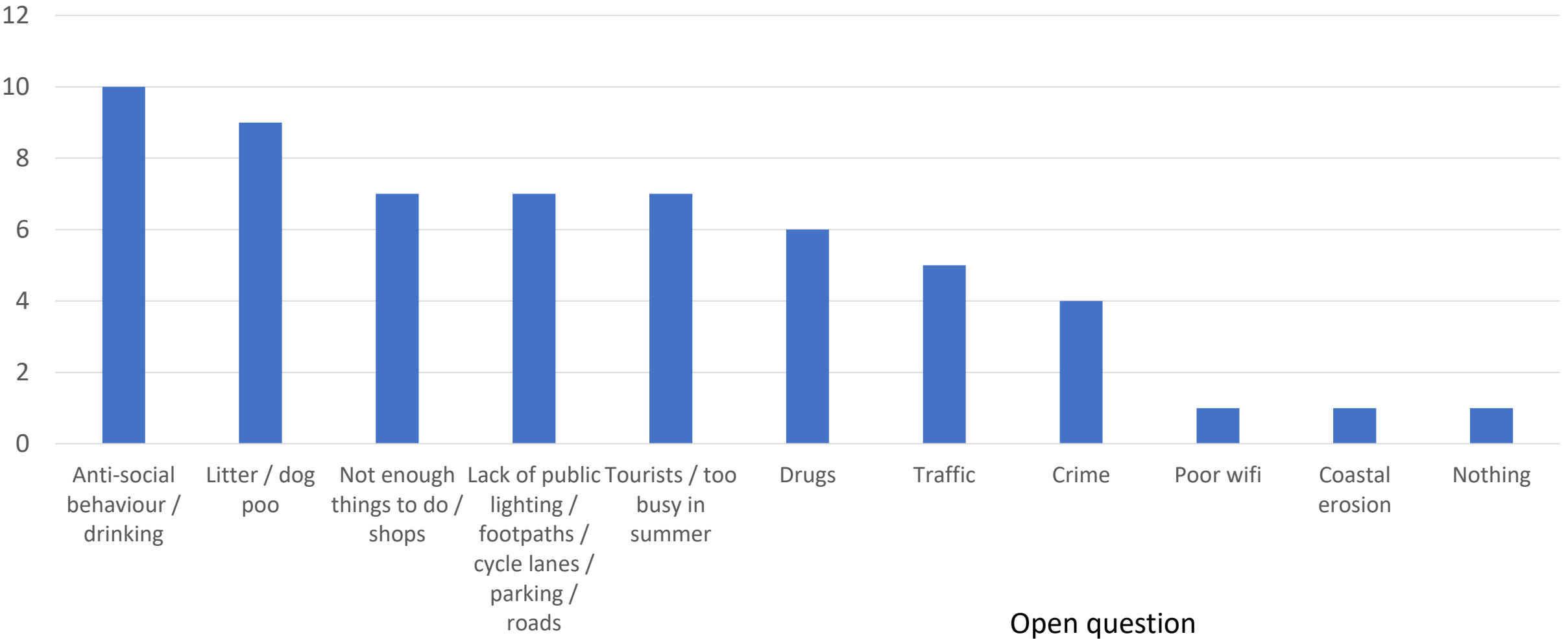
Question 3: What activities / facilities have you seen in other areas that you would like here?

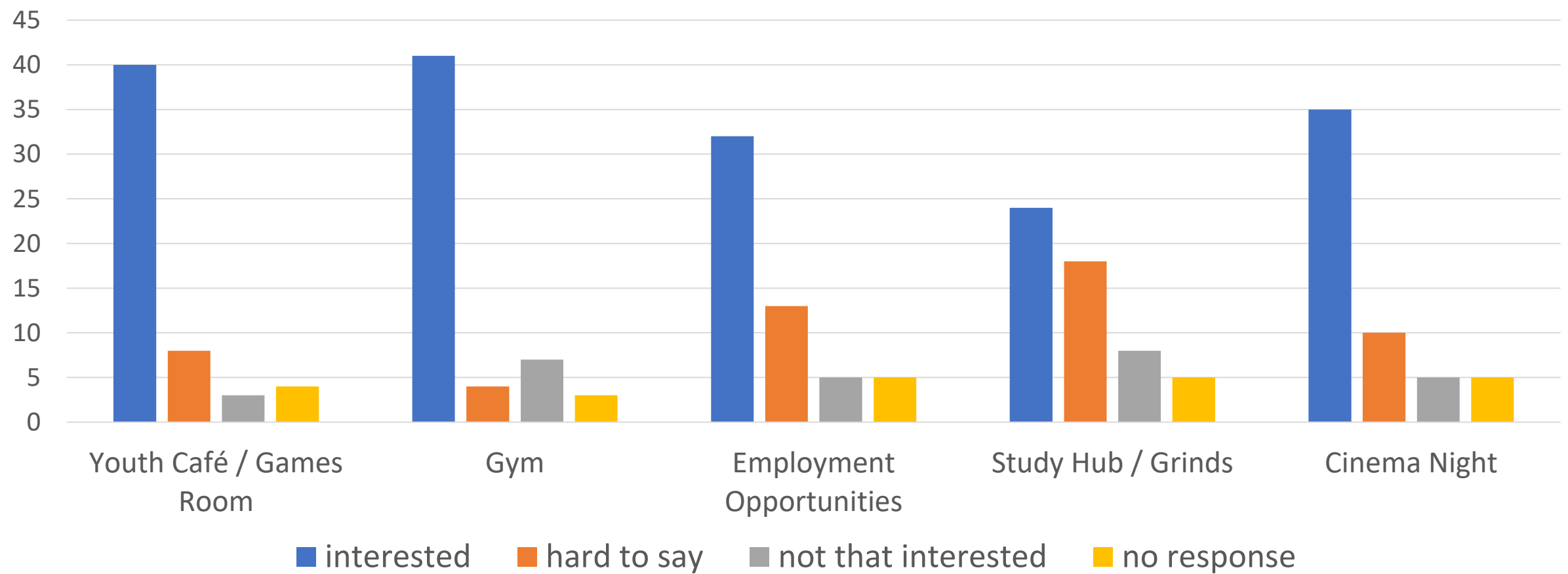

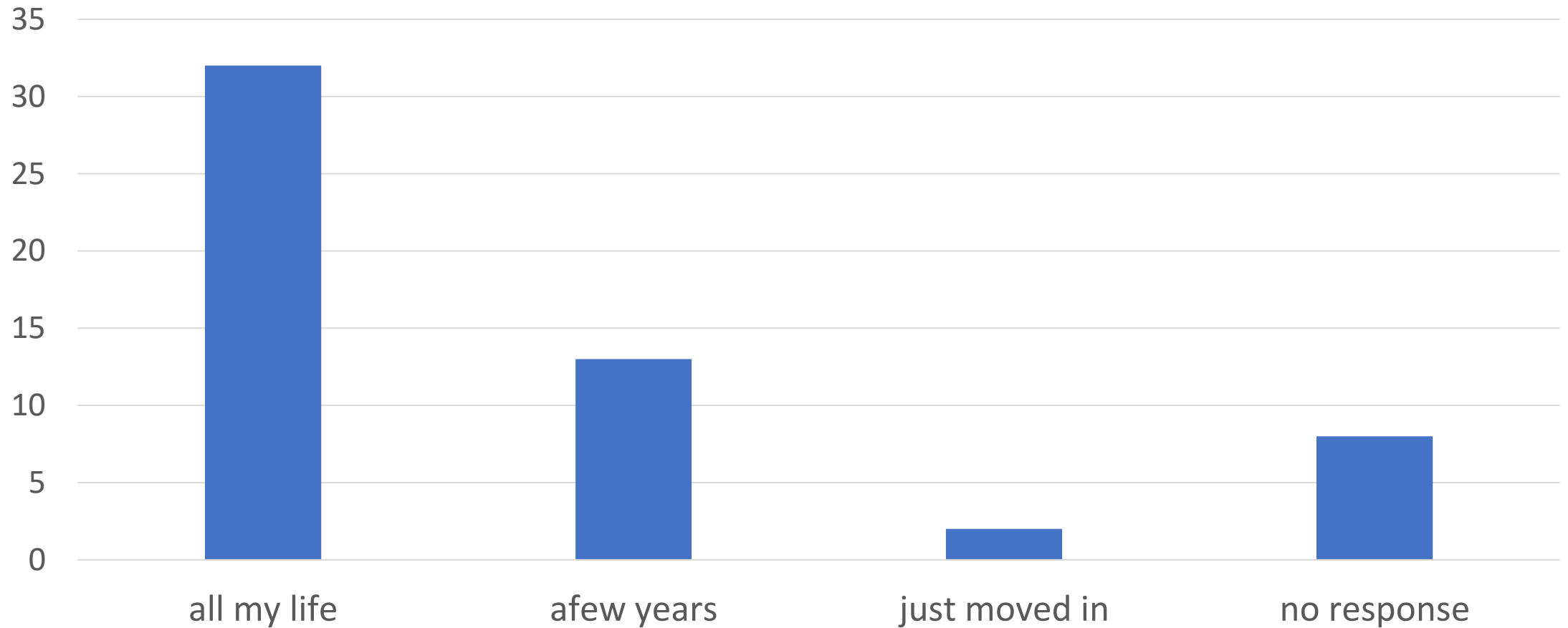

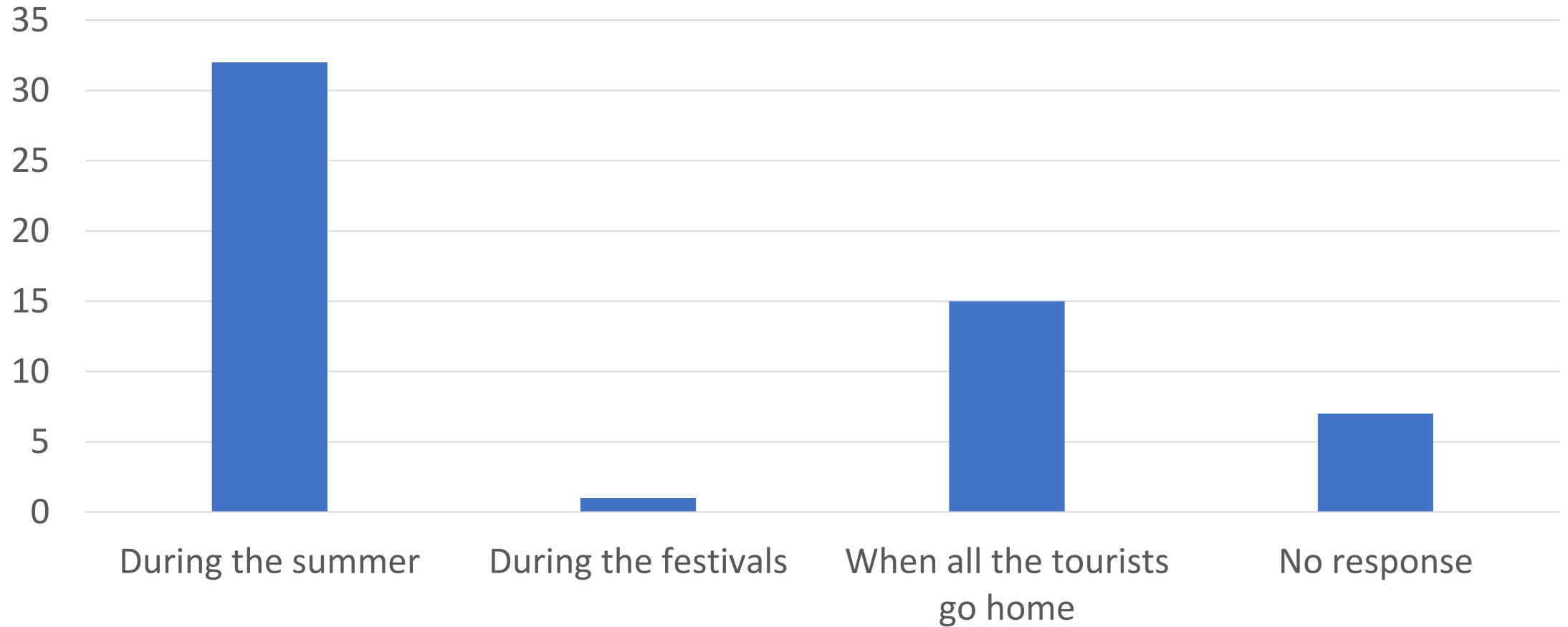
Question 7: Your opinion on the following possible initiatives?



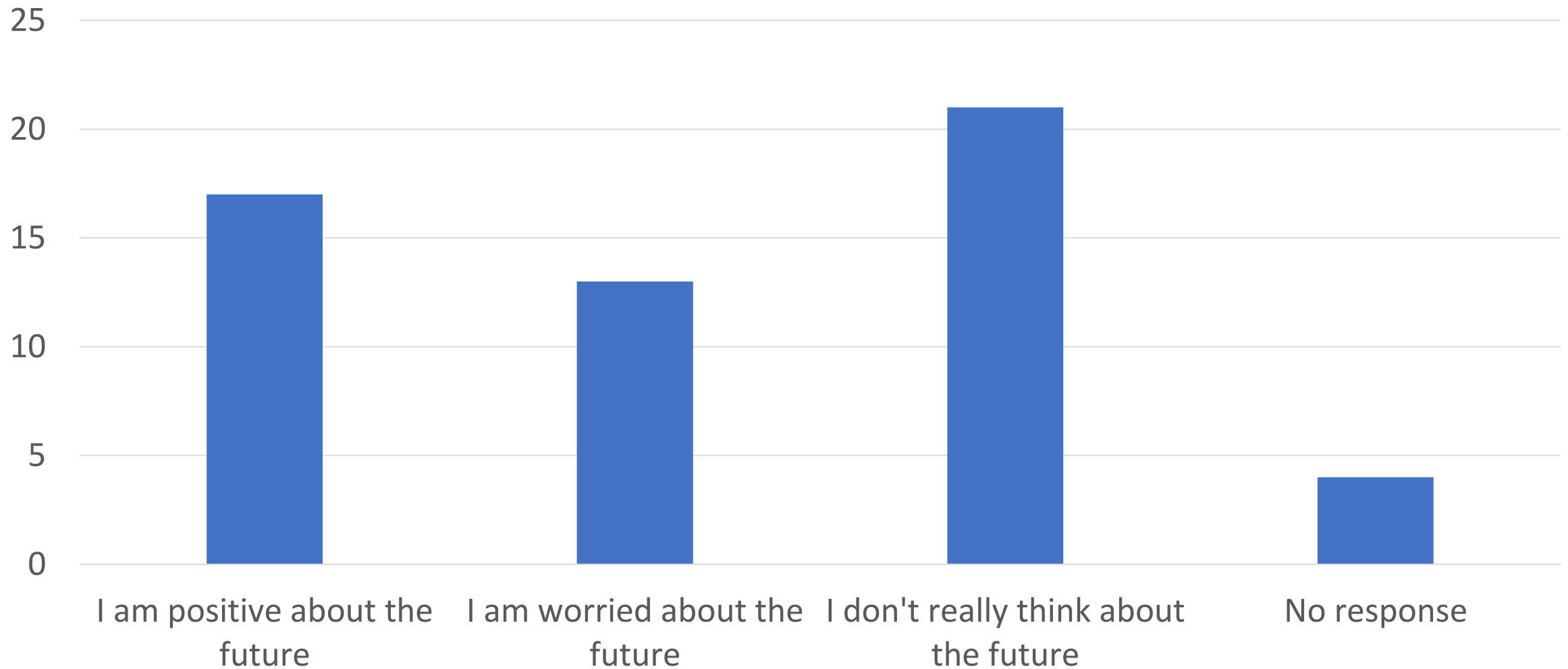
Question 8: How long are you living here?



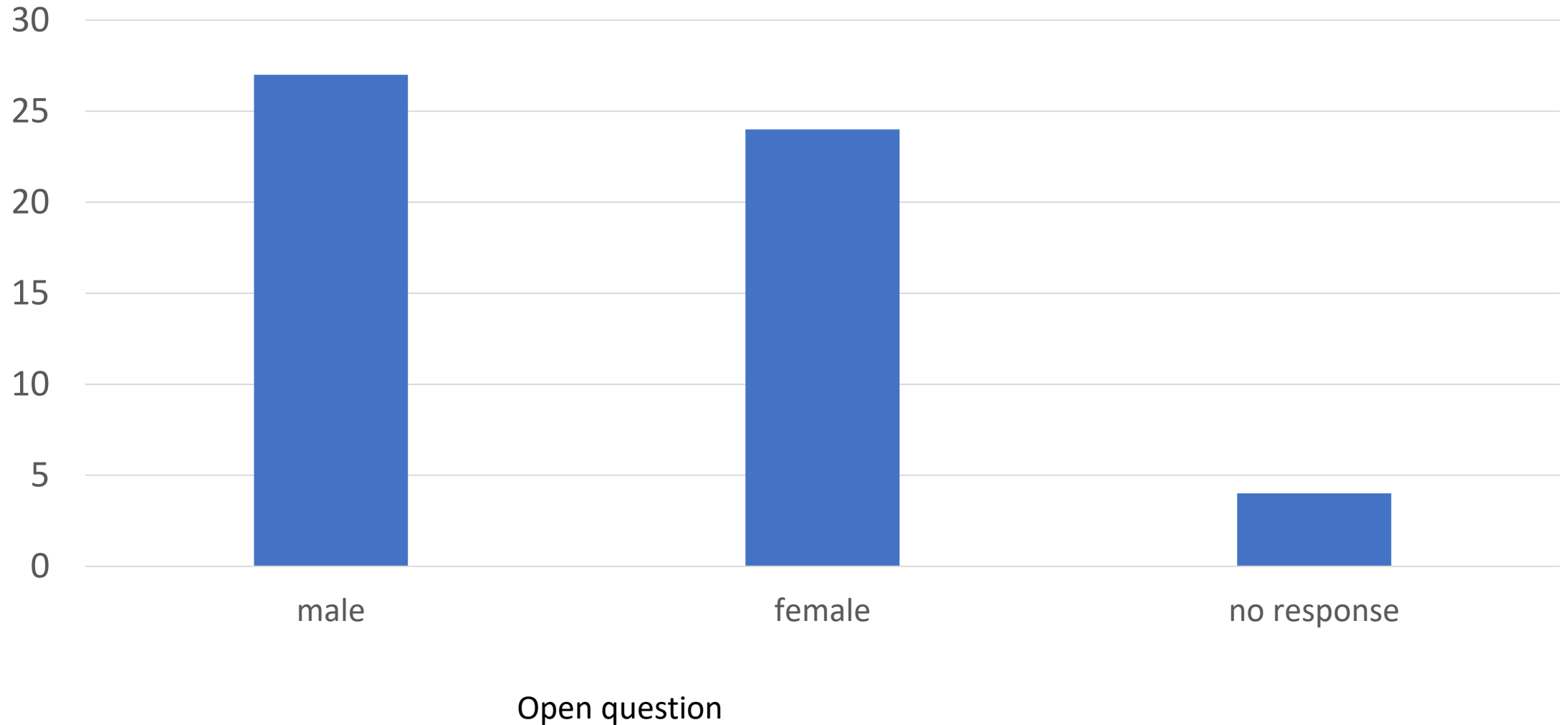
Question 9: I like Rosslare best?



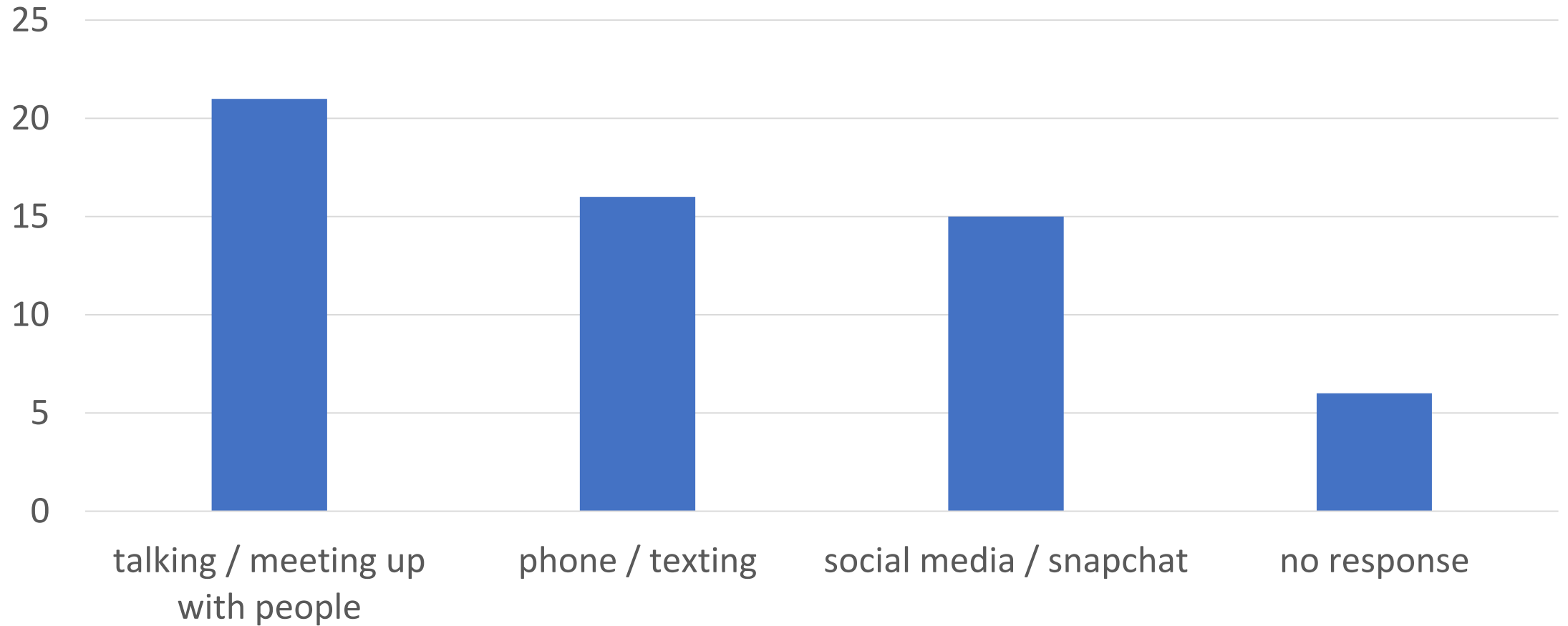
Question 10: Which of these describes you best right now?
