Rosslare Tidy Towns For the 4th consecutive year Rosslare has achieved a fantastic result in the National Tidy Towns Competition. Having already achieved 3 Bronze Medals we are thrilled to announce that Rosslare has been awarded a Silver Medal for 2019. This year there were 918 Entries and out of that, only 34 (under 4 %) Silver Medals Awards were granted so the Community has every right to celebrate. We congratulate Wexford Town on a similar achievement making it 2 Silvers for the County out of 34 Entries. We were also Winners in the SuperValu Community Hero Awards with Dara Meyler getting the Honours. We will issue the full report later but for now a huge vote of thanks to our Volunteer Group, and our thanks also to every person, volunteer and otherwise, who helped us throughout the year thereby making it possible to bring this very positive achievement to Rosslare.

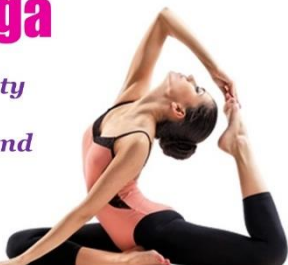
